After a dinner of Babe's Chicken, we will hear from Philip De Courcy.

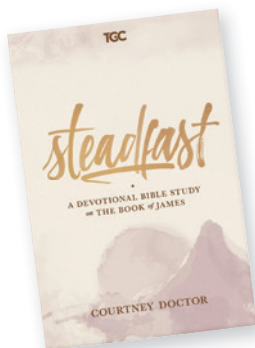
We will round out the night with games in the Gym and board games in the Chapel.
