Levanta Ministries

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Jenna & Crisandro Reyes serve in the Dominican Republic with Levanta Ministries, a Christ-centered community outreach organization. Jenna helps lead a children's Bible class, discipless a young woman, and tutors elementary students, in addition to leading a children's English class and a book club for moms of littles. Crisandro directs the Spiritual Department for Levanta by leading staff devotionals, evangelistic events, and programs (such as VBS) while teaching adult and youth Bible studies. He also discipless new



believers, engages in community evangelism, preaches at their church and other local churches when invited, and is currently working virtually with Dusty Burris through the XL Ministries *Becoming a Biblical Elder* training manual.
