The Master's Academy International TMAI is an association of 20 (soon to be 26) pastoral training centers worldwide that have trained thousands of indigenous church leaders as approved pastor-teachers.

As Senior Vice President of Strategic Partnerships for TMAI, Eric preaches in churches and conferences globally. He and Debbie meet with supporters to encourage investments in scholarships and essential projects. Each year, Eric visits training centers to meet with leaders, graduates, students, and professors while evaluating construction projects, library expansions, technical upgrades, and translation efforts.

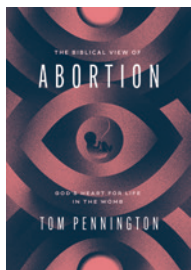
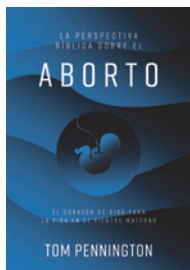
SANCTITY OF HUMAN LIFE SUNDAY

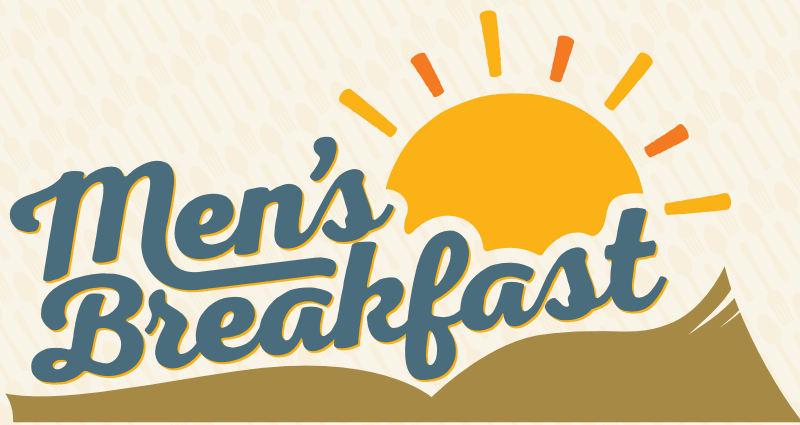
TEACHER TRAINING
