## Introduction to Luke

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**Author:** Luke

**Date Written:** Most likely Luke was written around 60–61 AD.

**Theme of the Book:** Jesus as the “Son of Man”

**Outline of the Book:**

- I. The Birth of the Son of Man (1)
- II. The Ministry of the Son of Man (4-19)
- III. The Crucifixion and Resurrection of the Son of Man (20-24)

**Key Chapters**

- **2** – Birth of Christ
- **4** – Jesus is tempted in the wilderness and begins his Galilean ministry
- **19** – Passion Week begins
- **23-24** – Jesus is crucified, dies, resurrects, and ascends

**Key Passages**

- **6:1-11** – Jesus is Lord of the Sabbath
- **13:1-5** – Repent and believe the gospel
- **15:10** – There is joy in heaven when a sinner repents
- **18:31-33** – Jesus prepares to depart for Jerusalem

**Summary Statement:** “Luke wrote his gospel so that his readers would understand that the gospel is for all, both Jews and Gentiles alike, since Jesus is the promised one of God as prophesied in the OT and as attested through God’s saving activity in Jesus’ life, death, and resurrection. .” – *The ESV Study Bible, Crossway, 2001.*

If you are able, read the introduction section for **Luke** in a good study Bible (MacArthur, ESV).

Make sure to look over the basic outline of the book so you can better understand the flow of where the author is going!
