**BIBLICAL/THEOLOGICAL QUESTIONS**

1. Read 1 Corinthians 6:19–20. What do these verses teach us about the relationship between the Holy Spirit and our bodies? Why should this relationship challenge and encourage us to be mindful of how we use and treat our bodies in the Christian life?

**APPLICATION QUESTIONS:**

1. Read 1 Corinthians 10:31. Although a familiar verse, how often do you regular interact with it on a daily basis? Do you make it to your aim, even in the most basic things of life, to do them for the glory of God?

2. What are the things of this life that often hinder you from pursuing God's glory? Have those things become idols in your life? How do you determine if something in your life has reached the point of idolatry? And how do you fix this problem? Discuss.

3. How does our living for the glory of God affect our witness to a lost world?
